The Fondation pour la culture et les civilisations du Vin will welcome the Porto region as the Guest Vineyard for its temporary exhibition in autumn 2018.

Sylvie Cazes, President of the Fondation pour la culture et les civilisations du Vin, and Ricardo Valente, City Councillor in Oporto, have signed a mutual agreement for the next Guest Vineyard temporary exhibition, which will be presented in the autumn at La Cité du Vin in Bordeaux.

The Guest Vineyard temporary exhibition

In the autumn, the Fondation pour la Culture et les Civilisations du Vin will provide the opportunity for a winegrowing territory (a region or a country) to become a "Guest Wine Region". The aim is to introduce a wine region to the public from a cultural and civilization angle via an original and aesthetic exhibition.

Georgia was the first "guest vineyard" during the autumn 2017, as the oldest wine-producing country in the world. This archaeological exhibition co-organised with the Georgian state and the National Museum of Tbilisi was a success: more than 50 000 visitors have discovered the historical richness and quality of the heritage of this country.

From 5th October 2018 until 6th January 2019, La Cité du Vin will welcome the Port wine region, the world's oldest appellation, whose Upper Douro valley is inscribed as a cultural landscape in the UNESCO World Heritage List.
